AIRPLANE AT THE TERMINAL/GROUND EQUIPMENT

KEY NOUNS	VERBS	EXAMPLE SENTENCES
Stand/ramp/service area/apron	to be parked/to be positioned/to be placed/to be located	Airplane is parked at the terminal
Jetbridge (passenger boarding bridge), jetway/jetty/skybridge vs passenger ramp (airstairs)	to board the plane or to disembark (deplane)	Passengers are walking through the jetbridge to board the airplane.
A belt loader (baggage ramps)	To load (or unload) cargo and baggage	A belt loader is positioned at the rear cargo compartment while another one is parked by the airplane inside the special zone.
A catering truck (vehicles)	To load fresh food and drinks	The catering vehicles can lift up their platforms so that they reach the passenger deck of the aircraft.
A tug or tractors and a towing bar	To tow To push or pull the aircraft	The tug is a powerful tractor used to push or pull the aircraft. The tug is not hooked up to the airplane and is not ready yet to push the airplane away from the terminal. The pilots will soon request pushback.
A Dolly (baggage cart)	to transport, to deliver bags	A dolly train has approached the aircraft and the baggage loading is about to start.
Ground crew	to service the airplane to operate the vehicles, to monitor or control the activities on the ramp	Ground crew technicians inspect and service the airframe, the powerplant and avionics. A technician on the ground has not connected the ground power source to the airplane yet. The ground crew is inspecting and clearing the ramp area of any foreign objects.
Safety cones and markings	to place/to position cones to follow the markings	The markings indicate the areas where ground equipment must be parked/located.
